

Designing a bright and sustainable future begins with stimulating awareness, encouraging creative thinking, and advancing action for a more sustainable and just world for all.



The Competition's Categories:

First Category (Children from 5 to 12 years old):

Color any of the illustrations in the Caricature Supplement using your creative style.

Second Category (Adolescents from 13 to 18 years old):

Provide a creative commentary on any illustration in the Caricature Supplement, effectively conveying its message.

For People of Determination:

Participants may record an audio commentary of no more than one minute instead of writing, creatively expressing their interpretation of the illustration.

Third Category (Youth and Adults: 19 years and above)

Write a paragraph of no more than 150 words summarizing the insights you have gained about sustainability from one of the caricatures, using one of the official languages of the association (Arabic, English, or French).

For People of Determination:

Participants may submit their entry as an audio recording of no more than two minutes, creatively expressing their thoughts on one of the sustainability caricatures.

The Competition's Terms and Conditions:

- Must possess a valid United Arab Emirates National Identity Card (citizen or resident).
- Follow the Union Association for Human Rights accounts on X (formerly Twitter), Instagram, and Facebook.
- Retweet the competition announcement using the hashtag #UnionAssociationF orHumanRightsCompetition.
- Publish the submitted work (coloring, commentary, or paragraph) while tagging the Association's platforms and including the competition hashtag, and send it to the following email address: info@theuahr.org.
